Track Rules

Racing Fees

Members/Non members - 1st entry 15.00, each additional, 5.00

Practice Fees

Members- Free at all times during daylight hours. Night practices will be free to members on a scheduled basis.
Non-Members- \$10.00 per day per family

Track Rules

1. Minimum age to drive is 8 years old.
2. Children ages 8-15 must be accompanied and supervised by a parent or guardian at all times.
3. Minimum age for corner marshalling is 12 years old, with exceptions made for 9-12 year old on a per case basis.
4. Each racer must have a waiver of liability signed and on file with Tri-City RC Racers.
5. Please keep your language clean, there might be kids around.
6. Use only legal frequencies and the frequency clips during practice. Be sure to return the clip when you are finished with it.
7. Never turn your radio on in the pits, during a race or at any other time without having a frequency clip.
8. No reverse is allowed during races.
9. Do not drive in the wrong direction on the track.
10. No alcohol or controlled substances on the property. Anyone suspected to be under the influence, will be asked to leave.
11. No yelling, arguing or disrespecting turn marshals.
12. Stay behind the top railing on the driver's stand. If you lean over you will restrict the view of others.
13. If you cut a corner you must allow the car behind you, to pass you. Then you may proceed.
14. All racers must turn marshal after their race. If you fail to marshal you may be penalized one lap on your previous race.
15. It is the racer's responsibility to make certain the frequency on the qualifying sheet is correct, as they reported it at the time of sign up.
16. Corner Marshals must have both hands free during the race and be alert for cars.
17. Aggression or otherwise inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated, and dealt with in a swift manner (which may include being banned from the track).
18. Treat others as you want to be treated.

19. By registering and competing in a race, you are agreeing to allow Tri-City RC Racers to use your name and likeness, in reporting racing results and happenings on its website, newsletters and bulletins.
20. A driver jumping their car back over or avoiding a recognized barrier around the track may be penalized by the Race Director.
21. Drivers must participate or be responsible on an equal basis in corner marshalling and providing other assistance as deemed necessary by the Race Officials and Club board. Penalties may be applied to drivers failing to comply with this regulation. Drivers unable to come forward are expected to supply their own replacement or notify the Race Director personally.
22. The Race Director may at his/her discretion impose point or lap penalties for any racing violation. (corner cutting, unsportsmanlike conduct, abusive language, intentional hitting of cars, etc.) Drivers will be advised at the time of any penalty imposed. Continued violation of Club/Track rules by any Member can result in loss of membership.
23. When deemed appropriate by the club executive, merchandise or cash prizes will be given away as winner's prizes. Prizes will be awarded from a percentage of entry fees collected for each class according to a pre determined percentage scale among the class winners.
24. Club Members are expected to assist in setting up and tearing down the track and to supply assistance in track maintenance.
25. Racing protests will be dealt with on an individual basis by the Race Director and the Executive. Their decision is final.
26. In the event of an overturned vehicle the wheels must come to a complete stop before the corner marshal will reset the vehicle.
